

Annie SOEDT petitioned the court for a guardian because she was 79 years old and unable to take care of her own business. 21 January 1947

The court appointed L. W. SIEVERT of Rockwell City to be her guardian, as she requested $\mbox{him.}$

Annie SOEDT lived in Des Moines with her niece, Mrs. Nellie FRIESNER, who was paid to care for her.

In 1959 Mrs. Nellie FRIESNER was no longer able to care for Annie SOEDT, so she was placed in the home of Mr. and Mrs. Charles SAVAGE in Lake City, Iowa on 20 January 1959. I do not believe they were relatives, but again were paid well to care for her. (One of the ladies in the clerks office knew Carrie SAVAGE and remembered her keeping an old lady in the upstairs bedroom).

The guardian, L. W. SIEVERT, occasionally sold off property and bonds to maintain the poor woman. She owned land in Twin Lakes twp, Calhoun county, and also a home in Rockwell City; also some farm land in Palo Alto county. She had bucks!

The large file continues through 1959 with the eleventh annual report; then there is no more. I will go back to see if there is probate on whatever she had left.


