OBITUARY: NEW HAMPTON -- Evelyn Dahlen, 83, died Tuesday, Jan. 21 of respiratory failure at the New Hampton Nursing & Rehabilitation Center where she had resided the last two weeks. Funeral services here held at 11 a.m. Saturday, Jan. 25 at the Jerico Lutheran Church with Pastor Kent Dethlefsen officiating. Mary Beth Dethlefsen was organist, accompany-ing those in attendance as they sang "Rock of Ages", "What A Friend We Have In Jesus" and "I'm But A Stranger Here". Interment was in the church cemetery with Jim Brannon, Gene Dahlen, Roger Johnson, John Kramer, Joe Hildahl and Eric Broer serving as casket bearers. . Visitation was from 3 to 8 p.m. Friday, Jan. 24 at Conway Funeral Home in New Hampton and at the church an hour before service time. Evelyn J. Johnson was born Feb. 10, 1913 in Jacksonville Township, rural Lawler, the daughter of Thomas and Thorina (Swenumson) Johnson. She attended the rural school near the family farm and married James A. Dahlen Oct. 9,1929 at Crane Creek Lutheran Church. They farmed north of New Hampton until retiring. Evelyn moved to New Hampton in the Spring of 1979 where she has since made her home. She was an active member of the Jerico Lutheran Church and the Ladies aid. Ladies Aid. Since moving to New Hampton, Evelyn has been a volunteer at the Senior Citizens Center. Surviving are a daughter and son-in-law, Thelma and LeRoy Brincks, Washburn; two grandchil-dren and spouses Debbie and Mark Schaefer, Waukesha, WI, Darin and Angie Brincks, Washburn; one great-granddaughter; three sisters, Cora Eaton, Cresco, Ethel Murray, Greenville, SC, Ruth Fetherolf, Hesperia, CA.; a sister-in-law, Hazel Johnson, Alta Vista.
