"Death under any circumstances is sad to even contemplate, but when it comes when we least expect it and without warning claims a loved one it is doubly sad. In the death of Mrs. Mary Kennedy, Tuesday, such a cause resulted, and the news that she was no more was received by her many friends about the city as a shock.

Tuesday, Mrs. Kennedy went for a drive and to visit a friend who was ill, in the west part of the city. Feeling that as the day was fine it would do her good she returned home on foot. Reaching Camanche Avenue, within sight of her home, she was suddenly taken ill. She was assisted to the residence of Mr. Parsons near by, and a physician summoned. All that medical aid could do proved of no avail, and the end came in a few minutes later. She was dead.

Mrs. Mary Kennedy was born in Kings county, Ireland, and was 61 years of age. She came to America when a child and located in Chicago. In that city she was married to Stephen Lawler, and to them were born five sons, John, William, Joseph, Daniel and James. About thirty-five years ago they moved to Clinton, the father dying some years after. She was married a second time to John Kennedy, and to their union were born three children, Mrs. John Sheppard, Mrs. John McDonald and Thomas Kennedy, all residing in Clinton. Her second husband died about seventeen years ago.

The deceased enjoyed a wide acquaintance and by her excellent traits of character was held in high esteem by all. A truly Christian and charitable woman, a kind and loving mother, a good neighbor and friend to everybody, the death of Mrs. Mary Kennedy caused deep regret wherever she is known. She will be missed

The funeral will be held from the home, 423 Fourteenth Avenue, at 9 o'clock Saturday morning. Services will be conducted at St. Mary's church, followed by interment in St. Mary's cemetery."
