General Notes (Husband)

The name of the Fossen farm comes from Foss the Norwegian word for waterfall. Next to the Fossen farm we find the only real waterfall in the Jostedal Valley.

The Fossen farm is bordered by the Myklemyr farm to the west, and the Sperle farm to the north. Fossen has a shore on the Jostedal River of about 1.5 miles. The Ormberg and Åsen farm are across the river. The main courtyeard is located close to the Fossagjelet ravine, about 570 feet above sea level. The distance to the Jostedal Church is about 3¾ miles.

Fossen and Fossøy are typical names connected with this farm in Norway.

The Americans who descend from this farm either Fossen or Fossøyane section of the farm mostly use Foss as a family name.

Prior to 1805, there was only one farm unit at Fossen. There have been several divisions since then. Croft at Fossøyane were cleared in 1761, 1820, 1840, and 1915; Fossehaugen in the 1770's; while Hesetflaten croft was cleared in the 1830's and abandoned in 1840's. The Dalen croft was cleared in 1840's, and Uri in 1880's.

Many of the houses at the Fossen farm have been erected after 1890. There is one residential house, probably built in the later part of the 18th century, as a smoke house. It has since been moved and enlarged. There is one other residential farm house that was built in the 1820's.

OBITUARY: Hans Fossen.

Hans Fossen, 80, of 1022 Blaine Dr., was dead on arrival at a hospital Sunday (May 7, 1972) after an apparent heart attack at home. He was born in Norway and came to Stoughton in 1909. He married Marie Woolwage in 1925, and they farmed in the Stoughton area until moving to Madison in 1960.

He was a member of Christ Lutheran Church, Stoughton, and a veteran of World War I

Surviving are his wife; four daughters, Helen Fossen, 1022 Blaine Dr.; Mrs. Al Weiland, 1806 Northwestern Ave.; Mrs. C. James Weis, Baraboo; and Mrs. Richard FaVour, Rockford, Ill.; two sons Kermim, Cambmridge; and Harvey, Onalaska; a brother, Andrew,; a sister in Norway; and 11 grandchildren.

Funeral arrangements are pending at the Holzhuter Funeral Home, Stoughton.

Hans became a naturalized Citizen on 20 October 1909. Hans was discharged from the US Army on 24 March 1919. Hans was a mechanic.
