<p>OBITUARY: (New Hampton Economist; 27 August 1968) H. Johnson Funeral Held Monday. Hannah M. Johnson, 81, died suddenly Thursday, Aug. 22, at the Evans Memorial Home in Cresco where she had resided the past year and a half. She was a native of the Jerico area.</p> <p>Hannah M. Braham was born Oct. 24, 1886, the daugh-ter of Andrew and Carrie (Anderson) Brahm at Jerico. She attended the schools of the area and on June 18, 1912 she was united in marriage to Edward P. Johnson at the Saude parsonage. The couple farmed near Jerico until Mr. Johnson death in 1960. Mrs. Johnson continued to make her home on the farm until her illness.</p> <p>She was a member of the Crane Creek Lutheran Church and the Ladies Aid.</p> <p>Funeral services were held Monday, Aug. 26 at the Crane Creek Lutheran Church with the pastor the Rev. David Stewart officiating. Burial was in the parish cemetery. Casket bearers were: James Halvor-son. Duane Knutson, Stanley, Knutson, Linus Brincks, Kenneth Fossen and Eldred John-son.
