Funeral services for Bottolf (Butler) Vikdal, 90, retired farmer of Saude, were held Friday, Oct. 5, at the Immanuel Lutheran Church, Saude at 2:00 p. m. The pastor, Rev. Norris Hanson, officiated. In charge of floral offerings were Mrs. Thomas Attleson and Mrs. Alfred Vikdal. Interment was in the parish cemetery with Alfred Vikdal, Therman Johnson, Thomas Attleson, Sam Attleson, E. J. Attleson, John Peterson and Anton Sanderson as pallbearers. Mr. Vikdal died at 8:45 p. m. Tuesday, October 2, on the farm near Saude where he was born. Death was due to complications of advanced age. He had been in failing health for a short time. The son of Sjur and Gertrude Dybevik Vikdal, he was born June 28, 1872, near Saude. He attended the rural schools and spent his entire life in the Saude vicinity. He was united in marriage Cecilia Attleson on October 31, 1891 at Crane Creek. The deceased was a member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church. Survivors include seven children; Jens, Melburn, and Alice, all at home; Carl of Lawler; Oscar, New Hampton; Mrs. OIIs (Gertrude) Borlaug ,of Saude and Mrs. Paul (Valborg) Shimek, of Shell Rock; a sister, Mrs. A.C.
