

## Bernard Douglas services held

Funeral services for Bernard "Bud" Douglas of New Hampton were held at 10:30 a.m. Friday, November 3 at Redeemer Lutheran Church in New Hampton. Rev. Harvey Abrahamson officiated. Bernard, 80, died Tuesday, October 31, 2000 at Mercy Medical Center, New Hampton, of natural causes.
