NASHUA -- Carolyn Rilla Peters, 55, passed away at her home in Nashua on Feb. 1.

Funeral Services were at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, Feb. 5 at the United Methodist Church, Nashua with Pastor Linda Butler presiding. Music for the services was provided by Betty Orrie, organist, playing "Old Rugged Cross", Hymn of Promise" and "Amazing Grace".
