NEW HAMPTON -- Regina (Betty) E. Carlin, 82, New Hampton, died Friday, Aug. 18, 2000 at Mercy Medical Center-New Hampton of natural causes.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held on Thursday, Aug. 24 at 10:30 a.m. at St. Joseph Catholic Church with Rev. Carl Schmitt celebrating the mass.
