NASHUA – Avis A. Strike, 91, died Friday afternoon, Jan. 14 at the Floyd County Memorial Hospital in Charles City of natural causes.

Funeral services were held at 10:30 a.m. on Monday, Jan. 17 at the First Congregational Church in Nashua.

Burial was in Greenwood Cemetery near Nashua.

Visitation was held from 2 to 6 p.m. on Sunday, Jan. 16 at the Chenoweth & Son Funeral Home in Nashua and one hour prior to services at the church on Monday.

Avis A. Strike was born on March 9, 1908 in Nashua, the daughter of Reginald and Rena (Springer) Stuelke. She graduated from Nashua High School in 1925 and received her BA degree at UNI in Cedar Falls. Avis married Hol-
