

SUPERVISORS OF CHICKASAW PAID TOTAL OF \$6,816

Highest Amount, \$1,445, Was
Received by Lentz of
Alta Vista.

New Hampton, Ia.—The Chickasaw county board of supervisors received a total of \$6,816.04 during 1937 according to figures compiled in the office of the county auditor, Eugene Albaugh, Nashua, chairman of the board, received \$130 for session work and \$840 for committee work, a total of \$970. He received \$26 for session mileage; \$233.90 for committee mileage and \$35.31 for telephone tolls, a total of \$285.21.

Frank Lentz of Alta Vista who retired on Jan. 1, received the highest total. He received \$135 for session work, \$19.50 for session mileage; \$1,015 for committee work, \$272.50 for committee mileage and \$3.85 for telephone tolls, a total of \$1,445.85. Henry Drape, jr., Fredericksburg, received \$1,400.38. He received \$135 for session work, \$16.90 for mileage; \$995 for committee work, \$231.80 for committee mileage, and \$21.68 for telephone tolls.

Severt Roberson, New Hampton, received \$135 for session work; \$13 for session mileage; \$930 for committee work, \$278.90 for committee mileage and \$1.60 for telephone tolls, a total of \$1,358.50. A. C. Blatti, New Hampton, received \$135 for session work, \$1.20 for session mileage, \$1,035 for committee work, \$184.90 for committee mileage, no telephone tolls, a total of \$1,356.10.
