To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 11,790 for 160. acres, issued in favor of *Ara Crockett, Private Captain Spear's Company, Massachusetts Volunteers, War of 1812*;

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the *North West quarter of Section twenty-two, in Township ninety-one, North, of Range thirty. West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Dodge, Iowa, containing One hundred and sixty Acres.*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, *which has descended to Oliver A. Crockett, Le Roy Crockett et al, Scott Crockett, Olivia H. Wickwire, Emily Crockett, Milton Crockett, Nelson Crockett, and Frank Crockett*

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Oliver A. Crockett, Le Roy Crockett, Scott Crockett, Olivia H. Wickwire, Emily Crockett, Milton Crockett, Nelson Crockett, and Frank Crockett,*

the Tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Oliver A. Crockett, Le Roy Crockett, Scott Crockett, Olivia H. Wickwire, Emily Crockett, Milton Crockett, Nelson Crockett and Frank Crockett,* and to their heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, *James Buchanan* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
