

Brown, him at Law of Laid Mrs Brown deceased the Tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Hram & Brown Milliam St. Brown and to their

heirs and assigns forever.
