Land Patents

A **land patent** is an exclusive land grant made by a sovereign entity with respect to a particular tract of land. To make such a grant “patent”, a sovereign (proprietary landowner) must document the land grant, securely sign and seal the document (patent), and openly publish the documents for the public to see. An official land patent is the highest evidence of right, title, and interest to a defined area. It is usually granted by a central, federal, or state government to an individual or to a private company.

After the American Revolution and the ratification of the Constitution of the United States, the United States Treasury Department was placed in charge of managing all public lands. In 1812, the General Land Office was created to assume that duty.¹

The first land patents in Jasper County are dated 1848. This issue lists all of the Jasper County patents for 1848. If you click on the link in the chart, it will take you to the actual patent certificate and the number of acres. MW is a Military Warrant.

Bits and Pieces

From Newton Herald, 6 Mar 1908

Mr. & Mrs. R. B. Shankland celebrated their golden wedding anniversary at their home in Monroe Sunday.

Mr. & Mrs. Shankland were married at Geneva, OH, Mar 1, 1858. Mr. Shankland is a Civil War veteran and served under Colonel Thomas as a member of Co. 1, 36th Illinois Infantry. He was in the battles of Nashville, Chickamauga, and other important battles in the southwest and had many narrow escapes from death, and was also one of the many who answered the call of Governor Todd for volunteers to defend the city of Cincinnati, which was at one time in peril of southern invasion.

Soon after the close of the war Mr. & Mrs. Shankland moved to Jasper Co. and settled on a farm near Monroe. They resided on the farm until 1902 when they moved to Monroe. Mr. Shankland comes of good old stock and of ancestors who were noted for their bravery in the pioneer days of our nation, and Mrs. Shankland was one of those brave women who bore bravely the struggles and hardships during the War of the Rebellion while the men were fighting to save the nation.

They are the parents of eight children, all of whom are living and six of whom spent the day with them. They are G. E. Shankland of (Newton), V. C. Shankland of Mingo, Mrs. Nathen Dalton of Glidden, Frank S. Shankland of Des Moines, C. W. Shankland and Mrs. Harry T. Loar of Monroe. W. B. Shankland of Benton Harbor, MI, and Mrs. James Tilsley of Amoret, MO, were unable to be present.

New Heir Appears

Another, and one who claims to be sole heir of the estate of the late Heinrich Flammkamp, who died intestate in Marshall Co. in March 1907, has appeared in the person of Mrs. Bernhard Ludwig of Dortmund, Germany. Mrs. Ludwig claims to be a daughter of Flammkamp and such (sic) declares herself to be sole heir of his estate. Through her attorneys Mrs. Ludwig has caused to be filed a petition of intervention in the case of Mrs. Dora Coppersmith, a sister of Flammkamp,

who caused the court to order the property of his estate sold and the receipts divided among the heirs, who are all distant relatives and number more than a score.

Mrs. Ludwig's petition was filed barely in time, as the referee, A. H. Bergman, of this city (Newton), was preparing to divide the money among the heirs and settle the estate, which both personal and real amounted to some \$12,000. Notice came from the German Consulate at Chicago that under the treaty which exists between this country and Germany, Mrs. Ludwig is the sole heir, being the daughter of Flammkamp. Following this notice came the petition of intervention filed by a Davenport firm of attorneys who have been retained for Mrs. Ludwig. The petition claims the entire estate on the grounds that Mrs. Ludwig is the illegitimate child of Flammkamp. Further evidence of the justification of the alleged daughter's claim is given by the allegation that in the probate of Dortmund, Germany, there was in 1866 a judgment entered against Flammkamp for the sum of \$1000 in favor of Mrs. Ludwig's mother, as alimony for the support of the child. On notice of the filing Mrs. Ludwig's petition Judge Parker ordered the referee, Mr. Bergman, to withhold all moneys until further instructions. The case is unique and will be of general interest owing to the difficulty Mrs. Ludwig will probably encounter in proving her assertions.

Orphan's Courts

Probably the least used genealogical resource of all is the Orphan's Courts found in many states. These courts do not deal only with small children without parents, but also handle a variety of records which can be most profitable. First we must understand that the legal definition of an orphan is one who lost his natural father. It is not tied to the mother or to any specific age. Orphan's court records, called "dockets," are used to appoint or change appointments of guardians for orphans, incompetents, and sometimes indigents. They also record administrators for estates and frequently trustees. Many property transfers, inventories of estates, marriages, births, and deaths are to be found in these "Orphan's Court Dockets." You might even uncover an elusive maiden name for when a widow asks that an individual be appointed guardian for her son; it's possible that they are related.

Fraternal Organizations

About one hundred years ago, it is estimated that about 87% of adult males belonged to some fraternal organization, such as Freemasons, Odd Fellows, Knights of Pythias, Elks, Moose, and Owls, for example. The reason these organizations were so popular is that they were something of an insurance policy as they all had an obligation to take care of widows and orphans of their members. Records of these groups can be an invaluable genealogical resource.

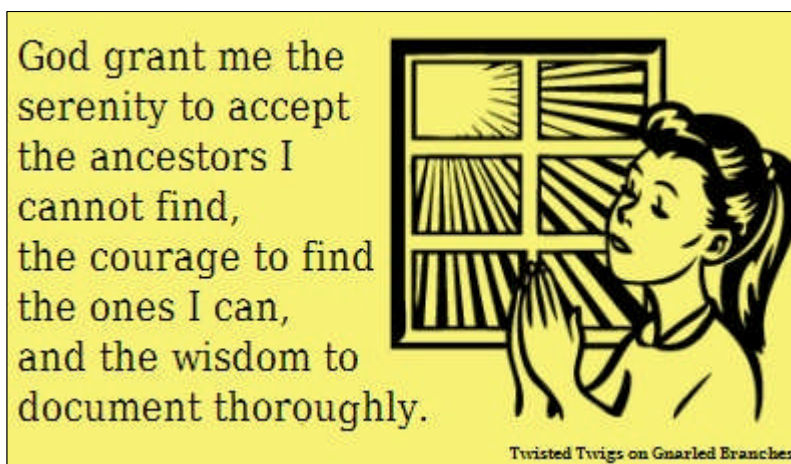
