Land Patents

A **land patent** is an exclusive land grant made by a sovereign entity with respect to a particular tract of land. To make such a grant “patent”, a sovereign (proprietary landowner) must document the land grant, securely sign and seal the document (patent), and openly publish the documents for the public to see. An official land patent is the highest evidence of right, title, and interest to a defined area. It is usually granted by a central, federal, or state government to an individual or to a private company.

After the American Revolution and the ratification of the Constitution of the United States, the United States Treasury Department was placed in charge of managing all public lands. In 1812, the General Land Office was created to assume that duty.<sup>1</sup>

The first land patents in Jasper County are dated 1848. Issue Vol. 34-4 (Nov., 2014) printed 1848. Issue Vol. 35-1 (Feb., 2015) printed 1849. This issue lists 1850- and 1851 land patents. If you click on the link in the chart, it will take you to the actual patent certificate and the number of acres. MW is a Military Warrant.
