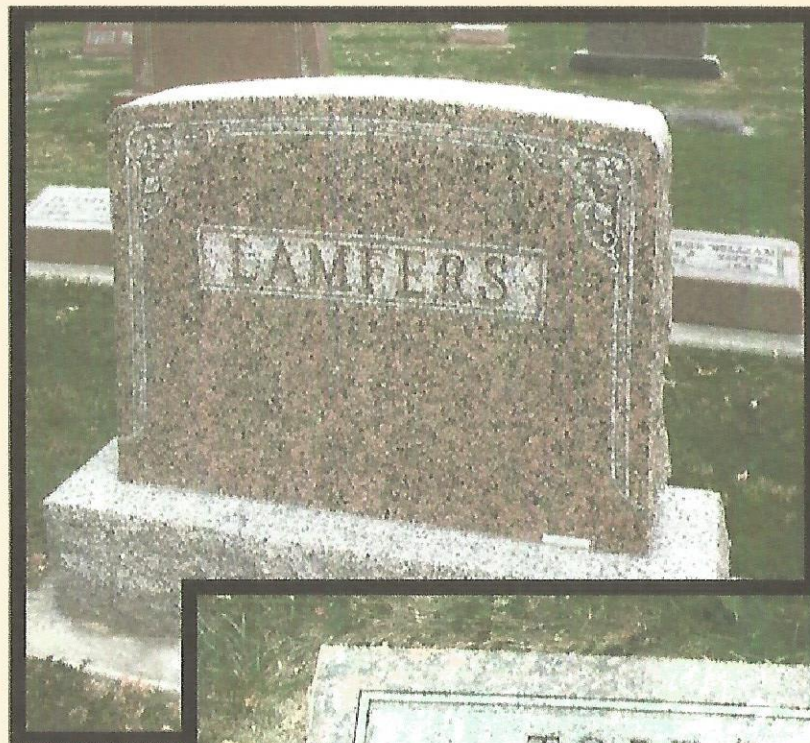
He received his schooling in
