Mrs Helen Leone Abrahamson, daughter of Dora Peterson and Carl A. Carlson was born Nov. 21, 1916, at Chicago, Ill. She graduated from the Evanston high school and attended a business school in Chicago. She worked for several years as a receptionist for a doctor before her marriage to Allan Abrahamson on Oct. 12, 1940 at the Emmanuel Methodist church in Evanston. After her children were raised, she was a para-professional for the Evanston and Glenview school systems for over ten years. They have resided in Harlan since 1972, with the exception of three years, 1977 to 1980 spent in Evanston.

She was a member of the United Methodist church of Harlan, P.E.O., Bethany Home Auxiliary of Chicago and Lake Bluff Children's Home Auxiliary. She died at the Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on Saturday, April 7, 1984 at the age of 67 years, 4 months and 16 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents and one brother, Raymond Carlson. Survivors include her husband Allan of Harlan; three daughters: Ann Marie, Mrs John Conklin of LaPorte, IN., Nancy, Mrs David Boettger and Linda, Mrs Patrick Deren, both of Harlan. She is also survived by two sisters: Mrs Dorothy Johnson of Evanston, IL. and Mrs Jane Albertson of Buffalo Grove, IL.; ten grandchildren, many nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Memorial services were held Monday, April 7, 1984 at the Harlan United Methodist church with Dr. Larry LaVelle, officiating.
