Victor Andersen, 66

CANADA — Andrew Victor Andersen, son of Steffon Gerlev and Sophie Christine Andersen, was born in Harlan, on April 13, 1913.

He was baptized in the Immanuel Lutheran church in Harlan. As a small boy, he moved with his parents to Canada where he attended school and grew to adulthood. He was employed as a trucker and logger in Canada until retiring around 1970. Since that time, Victor has alternated his residence between Innisfail, Alberta, Canada and Harlan. He died at the Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on Saturday, Nov. 3, 1979, at 66 years, 6 months and 20 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Leona. Survivors include nieces and nephews and other relatives.
