

Carl Andersen, 71

Irwin — Carl A. Andersen, son of Louie and Kristina Therkildsen Andersen, was born Nov. 20, 1908, near Harlan. He attended the country schools near his home. He married Leotha Richards on Dec. 12, 1941 in Omaha, Nebr. They made their home in the Irwin area where Carl engaged in trucking and had worked for Western Engineering for ten years before his retirement in 1972.

He suffered a stroke about three years ago and since that time has been a patient at the Manning General hospital in Manning, where he died on Sunday, April 6, 1980, at age 71 years, 4 months and 16 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents and by one sister, Marie, Mrs John Hansen. Survivors include his wife, Leotha of Irwin, by a stepdaughter, Carol Cantrell of Manning, by three grandchildren and two great grandsons, by three sisters, Mrs Martina Carter of Harlan, Mrs Helen O'brecht of Mo.
