

Donald Andersen, 39

DENISON — Services for a former Harlan resident, Donald Andersen of Denison, were held Tuesday morning here at the Zion Lutheran Church. Burial was in the Atlantic Cemetery.

A physical education instructor at a Denison elementary school, Andersen, 39, died Friday night at the Crawford County Memorial Hospital. He was an assistant coach for the high school football and wrestling teams at Denison.

He is survived by his wife, Lucille, an art instructor at Harlan Community High School; two sons, Kevin and Kiron, both at home; and his mother, Mrs. Frances Andersen, Atlantic.

Andersen was an all-state football player at Atlantic high school and later earned All-Big Eight Conference honors as an Iowa State University tackle in 1962.

He formerly was a coach at the Iowa State Training School for Boys at Eldora and also taught at Underwood. He took a special interest in coaching youngsters and was active in the Special Olympics for several years.

Andersen was also involved in the Little League baseball program in Harlan several years ago, and was a park supervisor in the city's parks and recreation program.
