

Emanuel T. Andersen, 82

Emanuel Theodore Andersen, son of Frederick and Krestine Madsen Andersen was born July 22, 1899 in Torslev, Denmark. He was baptized and confirmed at the Lutheran Church in Denmark and attended school in Denmark. In 1915, he came to the United States at the age of 16 and settled in Kimballton, where he was employed by various farmers in the area.

On Feb. 20, 1929, he married Margaret Marcusen in Kimballton. Two children were born to this union. After their marriage, they farmed in the Audubon and Shelby co. areas until retiring in 1964 and moving into Harlan. He was then employed as the greenskeeper for the Harlan Golf and Country club for three years until becoming employed by the Harlan Public Library as their custodian for the next 12 years. In 1979, he retired due to his health.

He died at St. Joseph's hospital in Omaha on Friday, Nov. 27, 1981 at the age of 82 years.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by six brothers and four sisters. He is survived by his wife, Margaret of Harlan; one son, Howard of Sioux City; one daughter, Bernice (Mrs Duane) Linden of Portsmouth; ten grandchildren and five great grandchildren; three brothers, Victor of Kimballton, Henry of Harlan and Frederick of Denmark; one sister, Margaret Ledet of Des Moines; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan on Monday, Nov.

30, 1981 with Pastor J. Harry Thomsen officiating.

Burial was in the Immanuel cemetery in Kimballton with Ed Troll, Fred Nelson, Dean Linden, Dana Andersen, Elliott Svendsen and Darrel Mathiasen serving as casketbearers.
