MRS FRED ANDERSEN, 52

Ruby Isadore Holman, daughter of George and Evie Holman, was born near Pisgah, Iowa, September 15, 1903. She died at the Myrtue Memorial hospital at Harlan, December 1, 1955 at the age of 52 years, two months and 15 days.

Her early childhood was spent in the Pisgah vicinity and after her marriage to Fred Andersen, February 12, 1937, she lived in the Harlan vicinity.
