The Life Story of --

Theodore Peter Andersen, 72

ELK HORN — Theodore Peter Andersen, son of Helena Veaver and Peter F. Andersen, was born Dec. 1, 1901 on a farm near Treynor in Pottawattamie county. On Febr. 11, 1925 he married Pearl Gutfenfelder in Atlantic. This union was blessed with five children. Mr and Mrs Andersen farmed in Shelby and Cass counties, moving to Atlantic in 1950. Mr Andersen worked for several years with the Cass county Maintenance Dept. He died at the Atlantic hospital on September 30, 1974 after suffering a heart attack at age 72 years, 9 months.

He was preceded in death by two sons in infancy, a sister, Susie Fredericksen and a brother in infancy. Survivors include his wife Pearl; three sons - Bernard of Atlantic, Delbert of Elk Horn and Merlyn Andersen of Marne; nine grandchildren three great grandchildren; three sisters, Mrs Chris (Frieda) Reich and Mrs Lulu Carr and Mrs Ella Reich all of Atlantic; three brothers - William of Atlantic and Olea and Viggo of Elk Horn, nieces and nephews and other relatives.
