Leona Anderson was born Dec. 29, 1900 southeast of Elk Horn in Audubon co. and she was the daughter of Gregers and Sena Gregersen. She was baptized and confirmed in the Elk Horn Lutheran church and had been a lifetime member. During her life, she had been very active in bible studies and women's circle of the church.
