

Anna M. Arentson, 91

Anna Arentson, the daughter of George and Mary Bjerg Arentson was born Dec. 17, 1891 on a farm in Monroe twp. No. 4 and helped her parents on the farm while growing to adulthood.

After her father died in 1914, the family continued to live on the farm. In 1946, she moved to Harlan, with her mother and brother Elmer. After her mother died in 1948, she continued to live in Harlan, and become a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home in Oct., 1977. This has been her home since that time. She died at the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan on Thursday, April 5, 1983 at the age of 91 years, 3 months and 19 days.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by four brothers, Martin, Elmer and Eddie; also one sister Rosa. She is survived by her sister Stella (Mrs George) Mickelson of Harlan; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at Pauley Funeral Home, Harlan, Thursday, April 7, 1983 with the Rev. Kenneth Arentson, officiating.
