

Edmund J. Bladt, 70

Elk Horn — Edmund Jacob Peter Bladt, was the son of Rasmus Andersen and Hannah Toft Bladt. He died at the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn on Friday, Nov. 28, 1980 at age 70 years, 4 months and seven days.

He grew up in Audubon county and attended rural schools. He was baptized and confirmed in Lutheran faith. He moved to the Salem Lutheran Home about a year ago. He farmed in Audubon and Guthrie counties most of his life. He served in the Army during WW II in the Africa and Europe.
