NIELS C. BOELTH, 80

Kimballton — Niels C. Boelth, was born Aug. 21, 1894 in Alstrup pr. Vest Hjermitzler, Denmark, son of Soren and Ane Sorensen Christensen. He was baptized in the Alstrup church in Oct. 1894, and was confirmed there in April, 1910. Niels came to Elk Horn on May 30, 1920, to his uncle and aunt, Niels and Trine Sorensen and their family. He was a butcher by trade and also farmed. On June 28, 1933 he married Amanda K. Jensen and transferred to the Immanuel Lutheran church where he was an active and faithful member. Niels and Amanda lived in Kimballton where he operated a store. Later they farmed 8½ years near Hamlin. For a year and a half they operated a store in Exira. In 1945 they moved to Kimballton. Niels died Wednesday morning, Mar. 26, 1975 at the Cass County Memorial hospital in Atlantic at age 80 years.

Amanda; three brothers and three sisters all living in Denmark - Soren, Kristen, Paul, Anna Marie Sivesgaard, Ane Dorthea Ostergaard and Sofie Boelt.

Funeral services were held on Mar. 29, 1975 at the Immanuel Lutheran church in Kimballton with Pastor David L. Peterson, officiating. Burial was in the Immanuel Lutheran cemetery in Kimballton with Howard Sorensen, Donald Sorensen, Ethan Sorensen, Merlin Sorensen, Verdon Sorensen and Thomas Hoffman serving as pallbearers.
