

Ernest P. Boldt, 89

Ernest Boldt, son of John C. and Doris Habersaat Boldt, was born Jan. 30, 1893, on a farm south of Irwin. He attended the Irwin area schools.

During WW I he served his country in the U.S. Army. He was a life long farmer, working with his parents and his brothers. They farmed at Sac City, Irwin and Miller, S.D. In 1963 they returned to Irwin settling on a farm in Greeley twp. This farm home has attracted many to the flower, fruit, and vegetable gardens.

He had been a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan since 1977. He died at the Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on Friday, Oct. 1, 1982 at the age of 89 years.

He was preceded in death by his parents, and brothers, George, August, Wilhelm, Chris, Louis, John, Fred and one infant brother, and his sisters, Elizabeth, Amanda, Sophis and Dora. Survivors include nieces, nephews, great-nieces and nephews.

Services were held Tuesday, Oct. 5, 1982 at the Church of Christ in Irwin with Pastor Jeff Wilson, officiating. Burial was in Oak Hill cemetery with John L. Steenhusen, Henry Paulsen, Gary Justice, Peter Steenhusen, Jr., George Steenhusen and Merlene Thompson serving as casketbearers.
