## Book, 3, Ruled 'Unavoidable'

AUDUBON — A coroner's jury has ruled that the death of Garnet Book, 3, was an "unavoidable accident." No charges will be filed.

Garnet, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Vincent Book, living two miles east of Gray, was killed instantly Saturday evening when struck in front of her farm home by a gravel truck driven by Cleo Leroy Riggs, 26, of Lime Springs.

Funeral services will be held Tuesday at 2 p. m., in the Lutheran church in Manning with the Rev. James Ansoerge officiating. Burial will be in the Manning cemetery.

Besides her parents, Garnet is survived by three sisters, Pearl, 7, at home; Mrs. James Lauderdale of Vail, and Mrs. Cyril Goecker of Farling; four brothers, Ronald, 1, Lloyd, 12, and Virgil, 18, all at home; and Pvt. Sheldon Book, Ft. Riley, Kan., who was in the middle of an 18-day furlough at home when his sister was killed.
