Amanda (Mandy) Sophia Boose, daughter of Hans and Christina (Hansen) Fredericksen, was born on a farm in Oakfield twp. in Shelby co. east of Elk Horn. She was baptized in the Elk Horn Lutheran church and later confirmed there on March 28, 1915. She grew to adulthood on the family farm and as a young girl, graduated from Mrs. Conrady's Sewing School in Exira.

On Dec. 18, 1917, she married Anton Martin Boose in Avoca. Three sons were born to this union. After their marriage, they made their home in Elk Horn where he was employed as a mechanic at the Ford Garage. After his death on Oct. 2, 1959, she continued to make her home in Elk Horn until Oct. of 1979, when she became a resident of the Salem Lutheran Retirement Home in Elk Horn and then a resident of the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in April of 1980. This has been her home ever since that time.

She was a lifelong member of the Elk Horn Lutheran church. She died at the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home on Saturday, Oct. 3, 1981, at the age of 82.

In addition to her husband and parents, she was preceded in death by four brothers, William, Henry, Alfred and Victor Fredericksen and two sisters, Agnes Lambertsen and Anna Petersen. She is survived by her three sons, Melvin of Elk

Horn; Ivan of Pryor, Okla. and Avery of Red Oak; ten grandchildren and eight great grandchildren; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at the Elk Horn Lutheran church on Tuesday, Oct. 6, with Pastor Eugene Soland, officiating. Burial was in the Elk Horn cemetery with Paul Hansen, Allen Larsen, Burton Esbeck, Gerald Petersen, Howard Sorensen and Sidney Christensen serving as casketbearers.
