## Beulah L. Brink, 73

DUNLAP — Beulah Lenora Brink was born on Nov. 12, 1903 near Kirkman, daughter of John and Carrie Peerman. She died Saturday, July 30, 1977 at the Dunlap Care Center, Dunlap, at age 73 years. As a young girl she was raised on the family farm near Kirkman and received her education in the rural schools. On Febr. 16, 1940 she married Chris Nollen in Omaha, Nebr. They lived in Harlan and Dunlap. Chris died in Dec. of 1958.

On May 15, 1961 Beulah married Chris F. Brink in Dow City. They made their home in Arion. Beulah continued to work in the restaurant business in Denison.
