

Ex-Elk Horn resident dies

John C. Brooks, former owner of the Elk Horn-Kimballton Review, died last week at a Council Bluffs Hospital. He retired in 1964, after being a printer and linotype operator for the Council Bluffs Nonpareil for 38 years.

He and his wife, Lois, would have marked their 58th wedding anniversary, July 14. Surviving are his wife, three sons, a sister, eight grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

Services were held at Grace United Presbyterian Church in Council Bluffs with burial in the Memorial Park Cemetery.

Brooks sold the Review to Paul L. Griffith in 1929 and then bought a weekly at Logan. This venture was a failure and he returned to Council Bluffs.
