Anne Buman was born August 21, 1884 to Ludwig and Mary Ann (Butcher) Buman in Harlan and died July 31, 1959 in Omaha, Nebr., at the St. Vincent Home, after several months of illness, at the age of 74 years, 11 months, and 10 days.

Anne Buman attended the Lord Lister School of Nursing and did nursing in and around Omaha before going to Wenatchee, Wash., where she done Public Health nursing. She lived in Los Angeles the last thirty years until retiring several years ago when she came to the St. Vincent Home in January of this year.

She was a lifetime member of the Roman Catholic Church. She belonged to the Red Cross and Social Service Nursing organizations.

Survivors include a sister, Mrs Carl Rosman, a brother, George Buman, and several nieces and nephews. Preceding her in death were her parents, brothers, ~~John, Joseph, and~~ William, and a sister, Rose.

Funeral services were held August 3, at 9 a.m. at the Our Lady of Fatima Church at Portsmouth, Iowa, with Msgn. N. A. Gaul in charge.
