Harlan — Carrie Irene Byrnes, daughter of Nellie Olsen and Louis Osterlund was born Jan. 7, 1898, at Crawford county. She died Friday, Nov. 21, 1980, at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan at age 82 years, 10 months and 14 days. She was educated in the rural schools near Vail.

On Sept. 4, 1918, she married Leonard J. Byrnes in Sioux City. They farmed south of Harlan for 12 years. In 1961 they retired to Ft. Collins, Colo., and returned to Harlan in 1972. Shortly before Leonard's death in 1978, they were privileged to celebrate their 60th wedding anniversary.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband - Leonard, five brothers and five sisters. Survivors include three sons - Howard L. of Ft. Collins, Colo.; Patrick J. of Harlan, Merle L. of Sapulpa, Okla., and one daughter - Mrs Leola Nagl of Estes Park, Colo.; by 15 grandchildren, seven great grandchildren, nieces, nephews and other relatives.
