Kimballton - Lars Jorgen Christiansen was born Jan. 8, 1889 in Denmark, son of Jens C. and Karen M. Olsen Christiansen. He was baptized and confirmed in Denmark. At the age of 21 he came to the U. S. On Oct. 15, 1919 he married Amalia Jeppesen. They lived in Audubon county, where he farmed and did masonry work. In 1947 they moved to Brush, Colo., and Amalia died there in 1949.
