

Henrietta Wulff Denny, 93

MONROE TWP. — Henrietta (Hattie) Wulff Denny, daughter of John and Kate Knott Wulff was born on a farm in York twp. Pott. co. south of Minden on Jan. 6 1884. Hattie attended York twp. no. 2 school. After attending Tabor College, she taught several area rural schools. Hattie graduated from Iowa State Normal Teachers College at Cedar Falls and taught school in Iowa schools. Hattie later moved to Calif. and taught school there for many years where she was awarded Calif. State Life Teachers Certificate. On Aug. 21, 1932, she married Harold Denny of Los Angeles, Calif. Henrietta was a member of the Tujunga, Calif. Methodist church and of the W.C.T.U., having served as a State Secretary for Calif. In pioneer times Hattie was a member of Silver Creek Sunday School and church and attended when services were held for a time in the former James Twp. No. 3 school, 1/2 mile east of the present day location. Henrietta Denny died after a long illness on June 27, 1977 in Tujunga, Calif., at age 93 years.

Henrietta was preceded in death by her husband Harold, her parents, two brothers, Lewis Wulff and Wilber Wulff and two sisters Viola Roberts and Elma Kime, two step-sisters Jennine Croft and Annie Christensen. Survivors include a niece - Mrs Ernest Luth of Walnut, nephews and cousins.

Funeral services were held at Tujunga Methodist church. Burial was in Forest Lawn cemetery in Los Angeles, Calif. A special memoriam service was read at Silver Creek Methodist church near Minden Sunday, July 3.
