Harlan — William Calvin Dodd, son of Sarah Massey and William Francis Dodd was born Sept. 21, 1911, at Carrington, No Dak. He died in Myrtue Memorial hospital, Harlan on Wednesday, June 10, 1981, at age 69 years, 9 months and 19 days. He graduated from Carrington high school in 1929 and attended University of No. Dak.

He married Lois Mary Adam on July 25, 1942, at Los Angeles, Calif. This union was blessed with two children. He had worked for 14 years with the J.C. Penny Co. During WW II, he served as a Capt. in the 70th Infantry Division of the Army for over four years. In Oct. of 1952, he moved to Harlan and had managed the Farmers Store for more than 25 years, before retiring in 1977. He was a member of the United Methodist church in Harlan and the Parian Lodge No. 321, AF & AM.

He was preceded in death by his parents. Survivors include his wife, Lois of Harlan; one daughter, Lynne (Mrs Larry) Coates of Grand Island, Neb.; one son, James of Eugene, Oreg.; two brothers: Francis of Colfax, Wash., and Robert of Dillon, Mont., and one sister, Mrs Melody (Gordon) Anderson of Lisbon, No. Dak.; by two grandchildren, nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Saturday, June 13, 1981, at Burmeister Funeral Home in Harlan with Dr. Larry LaVelle, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with L. P. Farner, F. E. Brouhard, Dan J. Buckley, Furman M. Miller and Wilmer E. Petersen serving as honorary bearers and Galen Plumb, Rex Sorenson, Henry Andersen, Frank Murtaugh, Robert McKeighan and Ronald R.
