Clarence V. Dunham, 75

Clarence V. Dunham was born on Aug. 13, 1899, near Nixa, Mo., son of Vernon L. and Mary Dunham. On Aug. 16, 1927 he married Ruth Munholland and to this union three children were born. He died Febr. 3, 1975 at age 75 years, 5 months, and 21 days. Mr Dunham had resided in Harlan, since 1934 where he was an apiarist.

He was preceded in death by Mrs Dunham in April 1973.
