MRS LEO P. FARNER, 63

Dorothea Jane Farner, the daughter of Edna and Ray Huckins, was born on November 19, 1907 at Griswold, Iowa. She departed this life at the Bishop Bergan Hospital in Omaha, Nebraska on August 22, 1971 at the age of 63 years, 9 months, and 3 days.

She grew to adulthood in the Griswold vicinity and moved to Harlan in 1927. She married Leo P. Farner at Ainsworth, Nebraska on June 1, 1932. To this union one daughter was born. Mr and Mrs Farner have made Harlan their home since their marriage.
