Nellie Kristine Fiscus, the daughter of Peter and Ane Jensen Petersen was born on Nov. 9, 1913 on a farm in Jackson twp., Shelby co. She was baptized and confirmed at the Bethlehem Lutheran church in Jacksonville. As a young girl she attended country school at Jackson Twp. No. 8. She grew to adulthood on her parents farm in Jackson twp.

On Nov. 9, 1931 she married Iliff Fiscus in Omaha. One daughter, Donna Mae was born to this union. After their marriage they farmed in Audubon and Shelby counties. In 1964 they moved to a farm southwest of Jacksonville. After Mr Fiscus's death on Oct. 1, 1967, she moved to Harlan, where she worked in the kitchen at Myrtue Memorial hospital for 12 years. After she retired she continued to make her home in Harlan.

She died on Sunday, Sept. 30, 1984 at her sister Viola O'Neill's home in Harlan, at the age of 70 years, 10 months and 21 days.

Besides her husband Iliff, she was preceded in death by five brothers Gaylord, Arnold, Harvey, Martin and Warren. She is survived by her daughter Donna Mae Murray of Harlan; one brother Anton Petersen of Harlan; one sister Viola O'Neill of Harlan; three grandchildren, Vicki Krohn, Ron Murray and Kristi Murray; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
