

**THE LIFE STORY OF —

Ida Irene Foxhoven, daughter of Guy B. and Eliza Holmes Miller ~~MRS~~ born May 12, 1911 at Defiance. She attended schools in Defiance. On Febr. 11, 1929 she married Clarence Foxhoven at St. Peter's and Paul church in Defiance. They farmed east of Defiance until moving to Manilla in 1934. Ida died suddenly while enroute to the Denison hospital from her home Thursday, July 1, 1976 at age 65 years.

She was preceded in death by her parents, two grandchildren and two sisters and one brother.
