Thelma Adelia Frahm, the daughter of Francis and Lillian Havick Fenton was born May 17, 1907, at Harlan. She died Saturday, June 1, 1985 at Myrtue Memorial hospital at age 78 years and 15 days.

She was baptized at the First United Methodist church and attended school in Harlan, where she graduated from Harlan high school.

After living in Harlan for many years, she moved in 1940, to Denison, where she worked at the Boy's Store. In 1958, she moved to Omaha, where she worked for the Omaha World Herald, and WOW and KETV television stations. While in Omaha, she also worked as a receptionist for Fitch and Cole Mortuary. After retiring, she returned to Harlan in 1978. This has been her home since that time. She was a member of the First United Methodist church in Omaha.

She was preceded in death by her parents. She is survived by one sister, Irene McLaughlin of Omaha; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Monday, June 3, 1985, at the Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan, with Pastor George Gibson of the First United Methodist church officiating.
