

DUANE I. GOESER, 19

EARLING — Duane Isidore Goeser, son of Alfons and Marie Goeres Goeser was born Oct. 13, 1955, in Harlan. He died May 8, 1974, in an automobile accident one mile west of Earling, at age of 19 years, 6 months and 25 days. Duane was baptized and confirmed in St. Joseph's Catholic church in Earling. He graduated from Harlan Community high school in May of 1974. Duane enlisted in the U. S. Navy on Mar. 3, 1975, and had just returned home from boot camp.

Duane was preceded in death by his brother, Dean Goeser. He is survived by his parents, Mr and Mrs Alfons Goeser of Earling, two sisters - Julie (Mrs Cal Lamprecht) of Newcastle, Nebr., and Jane Goeser, of Omaha, Nebr. and two brothers - Darrell, of Dunlap and David, of Earling; by his paternal grandmother, Mrs Mary Goeser, of Earling, aunts and uncles and other relatives.

A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated at St. Joseph's Catholic church in Earling, on Saturday, May 10, 1975 with Very Rev. Msgr. Michael W. Schwarte as celebrant. Burial was in St. Joseph's cemetery in Earling with Larry Gaul, Gerry Schomers, Mike Goeser, Richard Connell, William Graeve and Russ Heese serving as pallbearers.
