MRS CHARLES HAFERBIER, 84

Mattie Belle Haferbier, daughter of Asher and Lucina Hawkins, was born Oct. 16, 1889 on a farm near Persia. She died at the Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan, on June 2, 1974 at age 84 years, 7 months, 17 days. On Febr. 28, 1911 she married Charles Haferbier in Omaha, Nebr. After their marriage they farmed northwest of Portsmouth, until 1943, at which time they moved to Harlan. Mrs Haferbier was a member of the First United Methodist church of Harlan. She was also a member of the Myrtue Memorial Hospital Auxiliary. After the death of Mr Haferbier on Nov. 14, 1962, Mrs Haferbier continued to lived in her home in Harlan. In 1965 she became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home of Harlan.

In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by her parents; four brothers and one sister. She is survived by her sister - Mrs Lottie Gramkow of Harlan; by her brother - Rubert Hawkins of Park Rapids, Minn.; by her nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at the Pauley Home for Funerals in Harlan on Tuesday, June 4, 1974 with Rev. Larry LaVelle, pastor of the First United Methodist church, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Roy Hawkins, Don Hawkins, Arnold Nelson, Claus Eckmann, Raymond Brown and Raymond Grobe serving as pallbearers.
