Joseph, son of Patrick and Nora Hanrahan, was born April 23, 1911, near Manilla, Crawford co. He attended the country schools. He farmed near Manilla and Buck Grove and also did custom work. He moved to Manilla in 1973. He was a member of the Sacred Heart church, Manilla, the Holy Name Society and was sexton for the parish cemetery.

He had been in failing health for several months and died at the Manilla Manor Nursing Home on Saturday, May 28, 1983 at the age of 72 years, 1 month and 5 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents, a sister in infancy (Catherine) and a brother, Francis.
