OMAHA — Services for Hans Hansen of Omaha, retired co-owner of the Globe Livestock Commission Company in Omaha, were held Wednesday at St. Andrew's Episcopal Church here. Interment was in Memorial Park Cemetery, Council Bluffs.

Hansen, 85, died Sept. 27 at an Omaha hospital after a lengthy illness.

He was born at Minden and was a former longtime resident of Council Bluffs. He was the third oldest member of the Omaha Livestock Exchange.
