

THE LIFE STORY OF —

John Hansen, 90

John Rudolph Hansen was born to John M. Hansen and Emma Klindt Hansen on Aug. 4, 1893 in Shelby co. and died on Wednesday, Jan. 26, 1983 at Myrtue Memorial hospital, Harlan, following an extended illness. He was 90 years, five months and 22 days of age.

He lived in the Shelby co. and Avoca areas most of his life and farmed in the Fairview twp., Shelby co. until 1966 when he retired and he and his wife, Wilma, moved to Avoca. He and Wilma have been residents of the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan since 1977.

He married Wilma Bornholdt of Avoca on Aug. 23, 1921. He was a faithful member of Trinity Lutheran church of Avoca. Burial was at Graceland cemetery near Avoca.

He was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers, Otto and Herman Hansen and one sister, Ida Kuhl. He is survived by his wife Wilma of Harlan and one sister, Mrs Lillie Rosenow, of Walnut; besides nieces, nephews and other relatives.
