PERSIA — W.F. (Hine) Hansen, son of Edgar and Mabel Hansen was born May 14, 1916 in Persia. He was baptized in the Trinity Lutheran church in Persia and was a life time member.

On Dec. 14, 1938 he married Elceda Foje. He farmed in the Persia area until 1959 when he purchased an acreage in Persia town. He was a truck driver for Red-D-Mix Concrete until his health forced him to retire in 1974.

He was well known in the vicinity for his banjo playing at dances and special events. He died Friday Nov. 6, 1981 at his home.
