

George Lee Harris, 59

ANAHEIM, CALIF. — George Lee Harris, whose parents operated several Avoca businesses in the 1930's, died Oct. 14 at Anaheim Memorial Hospital.

Shirlee Stahl Roecker of San Diego, Calif., reported that Harris' parents ran the Avoca Cafe and Bakery, as well as the Avoca Theater and Ice Cream Shop.

In 1938, George Lee Harris, then 16, contracted polio. When his health allowed him to travel, the Harrises moved to California.

George Lee Harris was a member of the California Bar Association and the Orange County Bar Association. He was a graduate of UCLA and USC.

Surviving are his mother, Mrs. E. K. Harris of Anaheim; his wife, Jean of Anaheim; two children, Leslie Woods of Orange, and George Harris, Jr., of Anaheim; two brothers, Eugene of LaHabra, and Jack of Newport Beach; a sister,
