Salome Mary Henderson was born in Pleasant Twp., Pottawattamie co., on June 1, 1889. She was the daughter of George and Mary Nold Haas. She was one of five children in the family. She attended country school near her home until high school when she went to Shelby. She graduated from the Shelby high school in the Class of 1906.

After graduation, Salome taught school in Minden twp., Pottawattamie co. until she married Andrew Henderson on Feb. 18, 1911. They rented a farm for a number of years until 1920 when they purchased their farm which was 4½ miles north of Shelby. They were the parents of two children Ralph and Thelma. Andrew died on Sept. 4, 1947. She and Thelma continued to live on the farm until 1950 when they moved to Shelby. She was a member of the Shelby Methodist church.

She lived in Shelby until her health began to fail and she became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan. She was a resident there for almost nine years.

She died on Tuesday, Feb. 16, 1982 at the Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan at the age of 92 years.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, Andy; one son, Ralph; one brother Franz Haas and three sisters, Lydia, Alma and Lilly Marshall. Survivors include her daughter, Thelma, her daughter-in-law Elsie Henderson of Harlan; one grandson, Gary and two granddaughters and other relatives.

Services were held Friday, Feb. 19, 1982 at the United Methodist church in Shelby with Rev. Russell Vanderhoef, officiating.

Burial was in the Shelby cemetery with Joseph Schleimer, Ralph McLaughlin, Richard Miller, Simon Pike, Delbert Pingel and Larry McCool serving as casketbearers.
